Trees come in bundles of 25. Trees must be ordered in full bundles.
 Trees must be picked up in Pine County at designated time and location.
 A 5% charge will be added to all orders not picked up during the published pickup dates & times.
 50% down is required on orders over \$100. All orders under \$100 must be paid in full when ordering.
 Deadline to cancel an order is March 1st. Any order cancelled after that date will forfeit half of the cost.

NOTE: If we are out of stock on any item listed on your order, we will process your order without the missing item. A memo will be sent informing you that a certain item is **Out of Stock**. A refund can be issued at pick-up time, or you may purchase any left over stock we have available.

Pine SWCD cannot replace trees that do not survive. The District reserves the right to change prices/substitute stock if needed.

⚡ These trees are not compatible with overhead power lines. Plant them AT LEAST 25 feet beyond the lines to allow for crown development and future line reconstruction.



*Improved = Stock that is listed as improved, has been grown from seed collected in seed orchards, managed in cooperation with the MN Tree Improvement Cooperative. Orchard trees have been selected for superior growth and pest resistance characteristics.

**Transplant = A transplant is a seedling that has been lifted from one nursery bed and transplanted to another. The transplanted seedling is planted at wider spacing, allowing more growing space. Compared to a seedling, a transplant has a more fibrous root system, and larger stem diameter. The increased size of transplants gives them an advantage over seedlings, especially on marginal sites.

***Seed Mix = All seed mixes come in 1 oz packets. 1 packet will cover approximately 500 square feet.
