Checklist for Maintenance and Use of Drills

- At least a ¾ ton pickup truck must be used to pull the drill when transporting
- Install the hydraulic transport locks before transporting drill
- Make sure the drive clutch is disengaged before transporting drill (on the left hub)
- Maximum speed is 30 mph
- Transport only during daylight hours
- When transporting make sure that all box covers and hydraulic tips are secured, and no seed is in the boxes
- When transporting watch for mailboxes, oncoming cars, narrow bridges and shoulders of road. Slow down and make wide turns
- Transport width of drill: 15'7"
- Working width of drill: 12'
- Need a tractor with hydraulics
- Minimum horsepower needed is 75+
- When seeding, lift drill at the ends of the field
- Never back up when drill is seeding
- Do not ride on the drill
- Do not operate drill with box covers open
- Lubricate all grease zirks every 20 acres, 1 shot of grease
- Cover drill (store indoors) when not in use
- Press wheel adjustments: each hole = ¼"
- For best seeding results, the tongue should be level during use.

Pine Soil and Water Conservation District Equipment Rental Contract



This rental agreement is made on _____ day of _____, 2022, between _____ (renter), and the Pine Soil and Water Conservation District (District).

These parties agree as follows:

1. Before pickup, the renter agrees to pay approximately 1/2 of the rental fee for the proposed number of acres intended to be seeded, at a rate of \$14/acre. *(There is a minimum rental fee of \$175.00)*
2. **District staff will not calibrate the drill for seeding.** Instructions for calibrating are found in the owner’s manual.
3. Drill should be picked up and dropped off between the hours of 8:30am – 4:00pm at all drop site locations.
4. After the seeding has been completed, the renter agrees to contact the District office with the count from the acre meter on the drill. The district will then calculate the remaining balance due. The renter then sends the final payment to the district. These charges are not subject to Minnesota sales tax. It is agreed that these charges will be paid within 30 days from the date of invoice. An 18% monthly service charge will be added after 30 days.
5. The renter shall not hold the District responsible for claims and liabilities arising from the use, operation, or storage of the equipment while in the possession of the renter. The renter shall indemnify the District for any losses suffered due to the operation, use, and storage of the equipment by the renter or someone acting under their direction or control.
6. The District agrees to provide the no-till drill and do all normal maintenance and repairs on the equipment for seeding.
7. The District will instruct the renter in the proper care and operation of the drill prior to use.
8. The renter will adhere to the time scheduled that has been arranged. The District is not responsible for scheduling delays caused by weather, repair and maintenance, or failure of another renter to return the equipment on time. Use the drill the first day, if weather permits. We have a tight schedule to fulfill all requests.
9. A \$30 cleaning penalty will be assessed to the renter if the drill is returned with seed in the box, and the seed will be considered forfeited. This fee will be given to whomever cleans out old seed from the drill.
10. No fertilizer or pesticide shall be applied with the drills.
11. **If the renter notices any damage to the drill while preparing to use it, the renter must call Pine SWCD immediately to notify them. If the renter does not report any damage before use, and it is discovered after their rental, they will be held liable for repair costs. To contact the Pine SWCD office to report damage, call 320-216-4241.**
12. We reserve the right to refuse service to customers who have previously violated any term of the rental agreement, or who have interacted with our staff in a nonprofessional manner.
